You are invited to submit your abstract (maximum 500 words). Authors whose abstracts are selected will be invited to submit a full paper for peer review. The title should be in Calibri font size 14 with the first letter of each word capitalized and the text centred. The Authors' names should be in Calibri font size 12, and the Authors' affiliations should be in Calibri font size 11 and italic. The main text of the abstract should be in Calibri font size 12. Multiple authors should be separated by commas. The number superscript can be marked to distinguish if the authors are from different affiliations. Please mark the corresponding author with a superscript "*". **The presenter's name should be underlined.** Page Size should be A4 with margins in normal and 1 spacing between the lines. Paragraphs should be justified (straight edged) on both left and right. Keywords should be included below the main text of the abstract in Calibri font size 12 and italics. The references should be as per the format mentioned below. Abstracts of a maximum of 500 words must be submitted online. Authors will be notified of abstract acceptance as soon as possible and by the deadline. Papers accepted for presentation may be included in the proceedings if published. Presenters must be fully registered and confirm their participation and attendance by the early bird deadline.
